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Regular bandage - Wound Care Instructions

- You may remove the bandage tomorrow and apply bacitracin ointment to the area.
- You may wash or shampoo the area gently.
- **DO NOT** engage in any strenuous activity that involved the area until you are advised it is safe to do so.
- You can take **TYLENOL** if you have pain but **AVOID** ibuprofen, Aleve and Aspirin.
- Call the office if there is excessive *blood or any redness and swelling* under the bandage or if you have *excessive pain or any fever*.
